## **Gov. Branstad Signs Proclamation for Protection Of Iowans Property Rights**

On June 6, 2012, Iowa Governor Terry E. Branstad signed a Proclamation reaffirming the rights of all Iowans under the Constitution of the State of Iowa. Our Constitution provides for protection of individual property rights and our individual liberties.

The Iowa state motto, "Our liberties we prize and our rights we will maintain" charges us with the responsibility to act in support of our unalienable rights.

The United Nations Agenda 21 is a voluntary plan adopted at the 1992 UN Conference on Environment and Development in Rio de Janeiro. This comprehensive plan for "sustainable development" wrongly portrays the American way of life. This Plan's stated philosophical goals conflict with the protection of private property rights and individual liberties.

Governor Branstad reminds us with his action that without a vigilant populace our Liberties are in danger. In response to the question, what form of government do we have, Benjamin Franklin said, "A Republic, if you can keep it."
